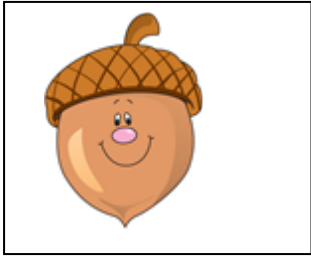


Announcements from Ms. Waninger
