What We're Learning Next Week...

Inquiry into Integrated Literacy

Next week we will be reading the book *This Is My Family* by Bobbie Kalman. We will be using text features to locate information, identifying the main idea and key details in the text, making connections between ideas within the text (as well as connections to our own families), and identifying differences between books that tell stories and books that give information.

Inquiry into Words Their Way

Thank you for working with your children on their word sorts each night! Please continue to sign the paper in your child's folder showing they have completed the homework.

Inquiry into Integrated Math

Next week we will continue to make 10 to add, explain addition strategies, solve addition word problems with facts to 20, and critique reasoning.

Inquiry into Transdisciplinary Themes

While you and your child are working on the timeline at home (directions are in your child's folder!), we will begin our first FOSS (Full Option Science System) kit here at school, Solids and Liquids. During our inquiry into solids and liquids, your child will have hands-on experiences with objects that make up our physical world. We will be observing, exploring, describing, investigating, sorting, combining and separating, recording, and reporting. Our first investigation will be an inquiry into solids. We will be exploring many different solid materials and observing the properties of solids.
