What We're Learning Next Week...

Inquiry into Integrated Literacy

Next week we will be reading two Ebooks about fire safety. We will be reviewing onomatopoeia, using expression while we read, discussing genre and features of non-fiction text, finding words with super silent e on the end, discussing how to ask/answer questions, making inferences, and comparing/contrasting the two books.

Inquiry into Words Their Way

Inquiry into Integrated Math

Next week we will be finishing Topic 2, reviewing for our test, and taking the Topic 2 test.
