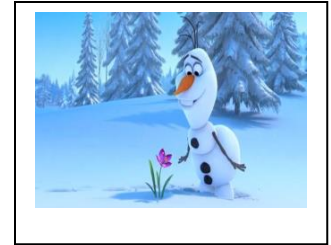

What We're Learning Next Week...

Inquiry into Integrated Literacy

Next week we will read the story "Rose Robot Cleans Up". In this story we will be able to make connections to how the characters are creative and also reuse old materials. We will also focus on long vowel sounds and silent letters such as 'kn', 'gn', and 'wr'. We will read the non-fiction text, A Bottle Takes a Trip, which describes the recycling process.

Inquiry into Words Their Way

We will have new word lists next week. Thank you for encouraging your child to practice their words at home each day!

Inquiry into Integrated Math

Next week we will begin Topic 14: Reasoning with Shapes and Their Attributes. We will begin by exploring 2D shapes.
