What We're Learning Next Week...

Inquiry into Integrated Literacy

Next week we will be reading a BookFlix book titled "Recycle That." We will ask and answer questions, use context clues, make predictions and connections, identify reasons the author gives to support points in the text, discuss fact and opinion, and identify the main idea and key details in the text.

Inquiry into Words Their Way

We will have new word lists next week. Thank you for encouraging your child to practice their words at home each day!

Inquiry into Integrated Math

Next week we will continue Topic 14: Reasoning with Shapes and Their Attributes. We will compose new shapes and use attributes to define shapes.

Inquiry into Transdisciplinary Themes

Next week we will continue our Sharing the Planet unit of inquiry by learning more about recycling. We will inquire into ways to recycle and make the planet a greener place!
