What We're Learning Next Week...

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Inquiry into Integrated Literacy

- Next week we will spend a lot of time working with our Reader's Theater scripts. Reader's Theater is a wonderful, fun way children can practice reading with fluency and expression, which also promotes better comprehension. Each day we will work on one aspect of fluent reading, such as reading like your talking, reading with expression (reading for punctuation) and voice, and reading with appropriate speed and volume.
- We will also work on being performance-ready by practicing the correct way to hold our scripts and follow along nicely while other members of our group are reading their parts.

Inquiry into Words Their Way

Inquiry into Integrated Math

- Next week we will continue Topic 11. We will be subtracting tens using a hundred chart and an open number line, as well as using addition to subtract tens.
