School Calendar Reminders

York Academy students are entering their final few days of school. Please be reminded of the schedule for the end of the year.

The last day of school is **Tuesday, June 4**. This will be an Early Dismissal Day for all students. The Lower School will dismiss at 12:15 p.m. and the Upper School will dismiss at 12:30 p.m. Please make the necessary arrangements to have your child/children picked up by dismissal. **We at the York Academy hope you have an enjoyable summer!**

For the last day of school, students and staff are welcome to dress down for the day. However, I would remind everyone that there are Dress Down expectations. Please refer to the [Student Code of Conduct](#) for a complete explanation of the regulations for casual wear during a Dress Down Day.

If students report for school and are inappropriately dressed, parents will be notified and required to bring appropriate clothing.

Summer Camps



For those students that registered for summer camps and have received confirmation, the camps begin **Monday, June 10 at 8:00 a.m.** Students attending the camps should enter the school through the entrance gate on Beaver Street.

Camps will be in session from 8:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m., and lunch will be served. Please make arrangements to have an adult present for dismissal.

Summer Reading Requirements – Upper and Lower Schools

It is critically important that all York Academy students continue to read over the summer break. The Academy requires students to read personally selected books while they are out of school. Children in kindergarten through grade four are required to read at least five books at the child's appropriate reading level, and students in grades five through 10 are expected to read three books.

Students are invited to visit the Lower School library to choose books to read on **Mondays (only) from June 17 through July 29**. On these days, the library will be open from **12:00 – 2:00 p.m.**

All students that fulfill their reading requirement and return their reading record to school in August will be recognized for their efforts. Do remember, it is important to continue the practice of reading for pleasure while not in a school setting. Your support is greatly appreciated.
