What We're Learning Next Week...

Inquiry into Integrated Literacy

Next week we will be describing characters, setting and major events in the story Along Came Toto. We will also be identifying words that suggest feelings or appeal to the senses, learning about contractions, and identifying the common vowel teams *ou* and *ow*.

Inquiry into Words Their Way

We will continue Words Their Way next week, so please look for the spelling sort that will be coming home in your child's folder.

Inquiry into Integrated Math

Next week we will be starting Topic 2 in enVision Math. The topic begins with adding and subtracting within 10 using strategies such as adding on and doubles.

Inquiry into Transdisciplinary Themes

Next week we will continue our first Unit of Inquiry, Who We Are. After exploring what a community is, we will inquire about responsibilities we all have within our own communities. We will relate our responsibilities to how we can be caring citizens.
