Traffic at the York Academy

The safety of our children is always a concern in our school. Please keep the following information in mind when dropping off students for school.

Busses need access to the school on the east side of Beaver Street. Please do not leave your car in this drop off area. Buses not able to access this are holding up traffic on Beaver Street.

Be reminded that drop-off of students from cars traveling south on Beaver Street is not permitted. The City of York has posted this section of Beaver Street as "No Student Drop Off." The City of York graciously permits our parents to utilize the parking lot on Beaver Street for drop-off and pick-up of students.

All students are to use the crosswalks designed. Our school provides a Crossing Guard to assist students and parents crossing Beaver Street. Please utilize this service to assure students safely arrive and leave our school.

Those students leaving the Middle Year Programme are to use the intersection for crossing. Students crossing in the middle of the intersection is an unsafe action and our objective is to provide a safe route home for dismissal.

Parents arriving for morning drop-off or afternoon pick-up are reminded not to use the parking lot at LSC Design. In addition, parents are asked not to block traffic on North Street waiting for students to exit the building.
