Important Information from the School Nurse

Attention parents of current kindergarten, grade 3, grade 6, and grade 7 students—If your child has not received the state-mandated dental and/or physical exam and has not turned the paperwork into the school nurse, your child will be receiving a screening at the York Academy some time during the month of May. According to Pennsylvania Law, dental exams are required for students who are currently in kindergarten, and grades 3 and 7. Physical exams are required for students who are currently in kindergarten and grade 6.

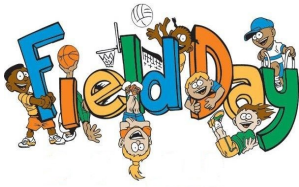


Construction of the Upper School
